

## PROOF OF VACCINATION – SAN FRANCISCO MANDATE

*Effective August 20, 2021*

The City of San Francisco has a new health order requirement for proof of full vaccination for patrons of indoor public settings, including bars, restaurants, clubs and gyms. This requirement also includes indoor event spaces where food or drink is served.

To ensure you are equipped to verify your attendee's proof of vaccination, City requirements are outlined below:

1. Valid forms of vaccination proof include *Valid Photo ID and*:
  - Original, copy or picture of your CDC vaccination card
  - or documentation from a healthcare provider
  - or personal digital COVID-19 vaccine cards issued by the State of California My Vaccine Record
  - or by an approved private company including one of the following:
    - CLEAR HealthPass
    - CommonPass
    - VaxYes (using their level 2 verification)
  - or similar documentation issued by another State, local, or foreign governmental jurisdiction
  
2. To verify QR codes digital proof:
  - Download the SMART Health Card Verifier App (through your mobile device's App store) to scan your attendee's QR Code.

All registrants will be required to attest that they are fully vaccinated in order to register for a UCSF CME activity and show proof of vaccination on-site at the course. UCSF will accept a photo of your CDC vaccination card. Please make sure that you bring this with you when you come to the course.

While you may have already considered this safety measure, we think you will agree this new ordinance will allow attendees to feel confident that their health and safety is the City of San Francisco and UCSF's top priority.
