

UCSF SAFELY MEETING TOGETHER REQUIREMENTS

Updated March 15, 2022

UCSF adheres to the San Francisco Department of Public Health COVID-19 health requirements, and, in some instances, our requirements are more stringent given our unique role as an academic, medical, and research enterprise. Our top priority is to ensure the safety of our learner, the UCSF community, and our patients.

In advance of the conference you will be prompted to provide documentation of full vaccination (meaning fully vaccinated plus booster once eligible).

Valid forms of vaccination proof include:

- Original, copy or picture of your CDC vaccination card
- or documentation from a healthcare provider
- or personal digital COVID-19 vaccine cards issued by the State of California My Vaccine Record
- or by an approved private company such as:
 - CLEAR HealthPass
 - CommonPass
 - VaxYes (using their level 2 verification)
- or similar documentation issued by another State, local, or foreign governmental jurisdiction

Onsite at the conference you are required to comply with indoor masking, except when eating or drinking.
